Rates are calculated using the Cost Analysis and Rate Setting Manual for Animal Research Facilities, No 00-2006 rev. May 2000 developed and published by the National Center for Research Resources (NCRR) at the National Institutes for Health (NIH)

The rates listed include standard husbandry practices utilizing standard Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) appropriate for the species, housing type and animal biosafety level. Rates for projects requiring additional services or non-standard PPE may differ significantly and will be charged on a cost basis. User must consult with Animal Resources in order to establish a budget. Rates are subject to review and revision in January and July of each year. Per diem is defined as the expenses required to maintain an animal or box of animals (Mice) for any portion of a calendar day.

We will no longer accept random source dog orders.

Cattle, Horses, Swine, Goats, Sheep — Ordering hoofstock animals should be completed well in advance to ensure the best chance of filling an animal order request. The ability to fulfill an order depends on the availability of these animals from local and purpose bred suppliers.

Hoofstock

- Required to undergo seven (7) day quarantine acclimation period
- Identified and receives physical examination
- Vaccinations and parasite treatments dependent upon species, source and animal health history
- Per diem charges starting accruing upon arrival at our facilities
- Animal costs based on market price for the species or established prices charged by purpose bred vendors

Charge of \$65.00 is 1x charge for the month used/rented for each dog used + per diem for each day used/rented. Administrative fees apply. Dogs must be rotated for each daily use throughout the rental/use period for the month

³ Includes animal procurement, setup, receipt, handling and all administrative costs associated with the animal order/delivery and animal rentals. Minimum is charged unless 5% of total exceeds \$10.00

⁴ Charges apply for all animal order changes or each transfer event. Transfer events are:
(A) Transferring animals to another Principal Investigator (B) Transferring animals to another Animal Use Protocol (C) Transferring animals to another account
