

Pfizer Travel Award for Residents or Graduate Students

(Effective for travel through June 30, 2005 only)

Purpose: To provide funding (up to \$500) for resident or graduate student travel to a scientific meeting to make a presentation.

Procedure: Applications for funding should include an abstract for the presentation and a cover letter giving pertinent details on the meeting in question. The student's major professor or resident mentor and the department head will sign the cover letter. Applications will be submitted to the office of the Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Affairs.

Deadlines: June 16, 2004 (for meetings July 1, 2004 – December 31, 2004)
December 10, 2004 (for meetings January 1, 2005 – June 30, 2005)

Selection: Factors included in choosing the recipient of each award are:

- 1) Content of Research
- 2) Scope of the meeting (national vs. local)
- 3) Whether or not the person has been invited to present the paper.

Recipients will be announced within two weeks after each deadline.

Students who have not received travel funds from the College to attend a meeting within the year preceding the conference under consideration will be given higher priority.
