Firstly, [The University of Georgia Policies on Use of Computers](#) applies to your use of UGAMail, as well as to the use of the aforementioned CVM e-mail distribution lists.

When utilizing these lists for e-mail distribution, please, be mindful of the fact that they experience a high volume of activity.

Use the E-Mail list most appropriate to your target audience.

Remember, [vetstudents@listserv.uga.edu](mailto:vetstudents@listserv.uga.edu) goes out to all classes and should only be used when you must contact the entire student body.

Student & Class lists should not be used to contact an individual whose e-mail address you do not know. Individual addresses can be determined using the UGA Phonebook on the web:

Subject tags should relate directly to the content of the email being sent. Using a tag such as "free food" to spam your classmates constitutes an inappropriate use of the list.

The address for the class list should not be given to individuals outside the College of Veterinary Medicine.

A violation of the aforementioned policies may result in your suspension from the lists. Repeated violations will result in removal from the lists.
